

BIG QUESTION: How can celebrate God's creation?

Task: At home with your family, make a worship space about creation. Choose some different pictures of creation, think of your favourite animals and plants. Think of your favourite places in nature, the beach, the park, the woods, the countryside. Light a candle and place a bowl of water and some flowers or a plant as a central focus. Ask each member of your family to say, "Thank you God for..." and pray together.



<u>Art Task:</u> There are many paintings which show the theme of God's creation. See how many you can find. <u>Creative Writing Task:</u> Write your own prayer of thanks for God's beautiful creation.

<u>Geography Task:</u> Compare a map with a globe. When you look at the map it seems that we are all separated, but when you look at the globe, you see we are all joined together as a world family. Look at all the different places of God's wonderful creation, the desert, the rainforest, the arctic, the sea, the sky.
