BIG QUESTION: How can we make good choices and be responsible stewards?

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BIG QUESTION: How can we learn from God's creation?



Humans are commanded to care for God's creation. (Genesis 2:15) All the earth is the Lord's. (Psalm 24:1-2)

Look at the way that the plants and the fields grow and give us beautiful things to eat and enjoy.

<u>Task:</u> What happens if we don't feed and water the plants, if we don't look after them as they are growing?

Find pictures of land that is suffering from lack of water and crops that have been spoilt.

Ask yourself: What has gone wrong? Why has this happened? How will it affect people in that area?
