Can you find hymns and pop songs to listen to on the theme of work?

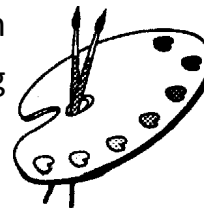
Make a list of your favourites.
